DECISION

Regarding the recognition of students meeting information technology competency standards during their studies – a requirement for enrollment in Applied Informatics for regular undergraduate students from Cohort 40 onwards, submitted in the August 2026 submission period

Pursuant to Decision No. 894/QĐ-ĐHNH (April 04th, 2025) issued by the Rector regarding the promulgation of the 'Regulations on Information Technology Standards for Undergraduate Education at Ho Chi Minh City University of Banking;

At the suggestion of the Head of the Department of Academic Affairs.

HEREBY DECIDES:

Article 1. Recognition of 86 regular undergraduate students from Cohort 40 onwards as having met the information technology standards during their studies – a requirement for enrolling in the Applied Informatics course, submitted in the August 2026 submission round.
