**NOTICE**  
**Regarding the warning about scams targeting students**

Recently, in Ho Chi Minh City, there has been a situation where scammers are targeting students to lure, entice, and appropriate their assets through various sophisticated and complex methods. In light of this situation, the Banking University of Ho Chi Minh City informs all students to be vigilant against scams and asset appropriation. Students should pay attention to the common forms of scams, which are often manifested in the following ways:

- Impersonating officials, lecturers, or staff of the University or forging documents, signatures, and seals of the University to inform students to pay tuition fees or other fees, or to follow steps to provide personal information with the ultimate goal of appropriating students' assets.
- Offering enticing promises that appeal to students' desires, such as: finding part-time jobs with high income, studying abroad, receiving high scholarships, or enticing students to participate in study abroad programs, summer sessions overseas, or practical experiences, and requiring students to pay a "deposit" fee to participate or to prove their financial capability, after which the scammers appropriate the money.
- Luring students to participate in and fall into traps disguised as "multi-level marketing": convincing students to use products for free, providing financial support to "get acquainted" with the job, and then enticing students to invest and promise to make them "young entrepreneurs" or "successful businesspeople." Alternatively, luring students to go abroad for summer jobs to engage in human trafficking activities.

- Exploiting telecommunications to call and text the students' relatives and parents to inform them that the student has had an accident and needs to be hospitalized. The scammers create trust by providing accurate information about the student and requesting the parents to transfer a certain amount of money for emergency treatment.

In light of the increasingly sophisticated and complex tactics used by scammers, the Banking University of Ho Chi Minh City warns all students to be aware and vigilant. All official information from the University is posted on the University website (<https://hub.edu.vn/>) and the student portal (<https://online.hub.edu.vn/>).

Students should only pay tuition and fees according to the announcements from the University posted on the University website at the link: <https://hub.edu.vn/thong-bao>.
